Student Scholarship Application Guidelines

To apply for the student scholarship please supply the following:

1. A 2-page double spaced typed essay describing your personal achievements and career aspirations.
2. A letter of recommendation from a clinical instructor. This recommendation should include student level of performance, motivation and ability to interact with patients and members of the health care team.
3. An official school transcript. (Online transcript copies are not accepted)
4. Completed application form from this brochure or from the Internet (www.adspn.org). Clearly print or type all requested information.



Faculty Grant Application Guidelines:

To apply for the faculty grant please supply the following:

1. Proof of current enrollment in a graduate program.
(Example - transcript, registration confirmation)
2. A one-page typed essay explaining why you should receive the grant. This statement should include your personal accomplishments, professional nursing goals, scholarly activity and its benefit to your colleagues, student body and the individual applicant.
3. Completed application form from this brochure or from the Internet (www.adspn.org). Clearly print or type all requested information.
